



## 2011 Scholarship & Grant Deadlines ... Closer than you think!

Northwest Suburban Teachers Union, Local 1211 members, dependents, and grandchildren are eligible for a number of union-funded college scholarships and grant programs. Review each program's eligibility requirements. January 31 and March 1 postmark deadlines fall on a Saturday and Sunday. Most post offices close early on Saturdays and are closed on Sundays. Contact the Local 1211 office for forms, or other related help if you need assistance.

<b>IFT Thomas H. Reece Scholarship</b> A one-time scholarship	IFT member, or member's child, currently enrolled in a public university with a declared education major or enrolled in a Master of Education program*	Up to \$2000	TBA Spring 2011

\*Local 1211 members are eligible for IFT, AFT, CFL and AFL-CIO opportunities, as noted. Former members, retired but not continuing active membership, are not eligible for IFT and Local 1211 scholarships. Current IFT Retirees membership *in good standing* is required.
